History of the H. B. Goodlin Foundation

The H. B. Goodlin Foundation was started with a bequest from Helen Goodlin, a resident of Fredericka Manor Retirement Community in Chula Vista. Helen contacted the San Diego branch of MTAC and asked if we could form a foundation to provide scholarships for young musicians from San Diego County. The Foundation was set up in her name and is operated by the San Diego Chapter of the Music Teachers' Association of California (MTACSD). Prizes are awarded to the winners of the annual scholarship auditions.

The fund has been fortunate in attracting annual contributions from other charitable foundations. The William E. Schmidt Foundation supports the Chet and June Schmidt Award, a keyboard prize of \$3200.00 to a first prize pianist or organist. The Apollo award, funded by an anonymous donor, supports the first-prize winner of the senior instrumental division. Another donor supported the vocal prize for one year. MTACSD is eager to find new donors for the vocal division, as well as the Junior keyboard and instrumental awards.
